The Slav received an exhaustive test during the two Alekhine–Euwe World Championship matches in 1935 and 1937 ...

The Slav Defense is a chess opening when the following moves are played: The idea behind the Slav Defense is: White is trying to secure his center pawn (the d-pawn) with a wing pawn (Black's c-pawn). If this is done, then White proceeds to dominate the queenside flank with his pawn side majority.
